We participate in the Coney Island Mermaid Parade, the 5th Avenue Easter Parade, Santacon and the Healthy Halloween Festival. KOSTUME KULT AT BURNING MAN & FIGMENT*



Kostume Kult hosts a costume gifting camp at Burning Man arts festival where 50,000 people create a temporary art city in the Nevada Desert. At this event, where people wear costumes all week long, Kostume Kult recycles hundreds of pounds of donated goods to help the uninitiated better understand the beauty of costuming. Many of these converts return home to spread the joy and now hosting costuming events where they live. In 2007, Kostume Kult helped launch Figment, an arts festival on NYC's Governors Island directly across from the Statue of Liberty... Called "Burning Man East" by the NY Times, at Figment we give away hundreds of pounds of kids costumes at this all-weekend, family friendly event.
